



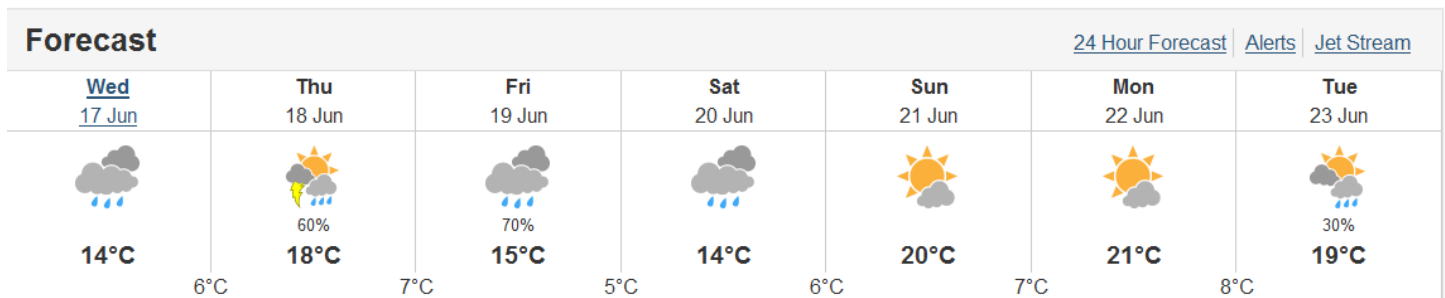

**Sampling and Monitoring Activities**

- Sampling and monitoring, (EPEA and Long Term Sampling and Monitoring Program), have returned to spring / summer requirements as outlined in the Long Term Sampling and monitoring Plan, 2015. An amendment request to reduce the sampling frequency on near-field sites was submitted June 11, 2015
- Data Tables have been included in the transmission.
- Extra sampling was completed from ponds that discharge to Baseline Creek (East Limb Pond 1 and South Plateau Pond 3). Results are included (2015 Extra Data.xls). OMM will be collecting additional metals samples from wastewater ponds during the next 2 weeks as well (June 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>).
- The half suite of extra metals and PAH sampling were not collected from Plante Creek locations during the week due to a police incident. Obed mine site was evacuated June 11 and returned to work late June 12.

**EPO Operations Update:**

Visual inspections of the sediment traps, silt curtains and stream flows are ongoing. Sediment trap clean out evaluation and scheduling is currently underway. Updated bathymetry data was collected June 10<sup>th</sup>. A work plan for the sediment removal is in development and will be communicated to the AER once complete. The AER will be notified in advance of the clean out process and will record and sample material collected as per the requirements under the Solids Recovery Plan and Report.

Weed assessments were completed along Apetowun Creek June 16 and 17.



**EPO Communications Update:**

DFO completed their fluvial geomorphological work along Apetowun and Plante Creeks.

Alberta Health has requested that the HHRA not be released publically until after they have had time to provide feedback and comments to the updated versions. The HHRA is anticipated to be released publically mid June.
